



“RN CHALLENGE CHECKLIST” for EMT

NREMT entry requirements for Registered Nurses challenging the EMT Training Program

Letter of Approval

Submit a letter from the state EMS office where the applicant works or is to work. The letter should indicate the state’s support of the applicant taking the National EMS Certification EMT (Basic) examination.

EMS Education Approval

Provide a certificate/letter of equivalency indicating successful completion of the current National EMS Education Standards.

The certificate/letter of equivalency must be validated by an educational program that is a current state approved EMT (Basic) educational program.

Pre-requisites

Provide official evidence of current and valid registered nursing credential.

Cognitive Examinations

Must be delivered at Pearson Vue Professional Centers or Pearson Vue Select Centers

Psychomotor Examinations

Provide verification of “Statement of Skills Competency” of successfully completing a state approved EMT (Basic) psychomotor examination.

Entry-Requirements

All applicants must meet current NREMT entry requirements.
